Artificial Intelligence (AI) Policy

Overview

With generative artificial intelligence (AI) tool becoming easily accessible to

students across the globe and in response to the growing concerns surrounding

the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in generating academic content, Asian

College of Teachers (ACT) has integrated AI content detection technology into

its assignment evaluation system to identify assignments that may have been

written using AI tools or significantly influenced by AI. ACT has felt the urgent

need to develop an AI policy to provide students with the necessary knowledge

about AI and maintain academic integrity.

Integration of AI Detection Checker

In order to uphold academic policy consistency, we have integrated the AI

detection checker into our assessment process and as an educational

institution, our aim is to effectively manage AI practices in accordance with the

ethical considerations.

Guidelines for Students on Al

An assignment is classified as Al-generated if it has been primarily composed or

substantially influenced by an AI program, tool, or algorithm, with minimal input

from the student. The use of ChatGPT or other AI tools for course assignments

will be considered as receiving assistance from someone else and raises the

same concern that work is not the student's own.



To maintain academic integrity, ACT is going to accept up to 25% of Algenerated content in the assignments. Should the AI content exceed this threshold, students will be asked to rework on the assignment and required to resubmit it.

This policy aligns with our commitment to upholding the principles of academic honesty, integrity, and intellectual rigor. Through this measure, we aim to safeguard the value and credibility of the learning imparted by Asian College of Teachers (ACT).
